This form can not be used to allow an individual or entity to sign as both buyer <u>and</u> seller confirming the Federal odometer reading. This may be accomplished only with the secure power of attorney (HSMV 82995) when:

- the title is physically being held by the lienholder; or the title is lost

CAUTION: A seller cannot give a dealer or his employee a non-secure power of attorney (HSMV 82053) and have him or one of his employees sign a federal odometer statement, confirming the mileage for both buyer and seller, as a dealer and his employees are considered a single entity.
